This is the announcement of the *Trends in Mathematics Education Research* conference (TiMER), which will take place in Krakow, Poland, on **September 13-16, 2022**.

All researchers of mathematics education, including aspiring scholars, are invited to attend and contribute.

### 1. Aim and focus

TiMER is intended as a working meeting for those who are interested in mathematics education research at all educational levels.

TiMER is an initiative to promote research in mathematics education among European researchers. It aims to bring together scholars not just from neighbouring countries, but from all over the world.

The TiMER conference will provide the possibility to learn from experts from the UK, Germany, and the Czech Republic about bleeding-edge research as well as methodological and theoretical approaches in mathematics education. Experts will provide training for researchers and PhD students. TiMER will also allow the participants to present, discuss, and disseminate different scientific achievements and ongoing studies in the field of mathematics education research.

### 3. Conference activities

**Plenary lectures:** lectures conducted by the invited speakers focused on methodology in mathematics education research. The plenary lectures provide a shared contribution to the conference and form a base for discussions.

**Oral presentations:** sessions of 20 minutes of presentations, followed by a 10-minute discussion. The presentations refer to studies in mathematics education research.

**Workshop:** involves a more extended type of contribution, focusing on different methodological approaches towards research in mathematics education.

**Poster exhibition:** a platform for unfinished studies. The posters are hung on the wall, and the authors are provided time to interact with conference participants.

#### 4. Publications

After the conference, all participants are invited to submit their manuscripts, which, upon successful evaluation, will be published in a scientific publication dedicated to the topic of the TiMER conference (publisher: Wydawnictwo Naukowe Uniwersytetu Pedagogicznego).

The conference is hosted by the Institute of Mathematics, Faculty of Exact and Natural Sciences of the Pedagogical University of Krakow, Poland (<https://matematyka.up.krakow.pl/>) and will take place on **13-16 September 2022**.

Further details on the participation, travel, and accommodation will be provided to TiMER-registered participants at a later stage.

#### 7. Language

The official language of the conference is English.

#### 8. Conference fee

The conference fee is 290 Euros (reduced fee for PhD students: 240 Euros), which includes conference proceedings and other materials, lunches, coffee breaks, and social activities for participants, such as an excursion and dinner.
